



Information Related to Faculty Appointment “Assistant Clinical Professor (Adjunct)”

This McMaster faculty status appointment is awarded to those who contribute a minimum of 150 hours over 3 academic years (July 1-June 30). Benefits include:

- MacID, McMaster email address, and use of above title
- Free access to online library
- Free (or faculty price) courses from the Faculty of Health Sciences, Program for Faculty Development
- Free access to the Hamilton Integrated Research Ethics Board www.hireb.ca
- Free use of classroom/meeting space at the One James North campus
- Consideration for travel funding assistance to present results of research at a scientific conference

Criteria and Initial Application

- MSc degree or equivalent
- Commitment to contribute 150 hours for the 3 academic years of the appointment with SRS
- Roles in the program identified and discussed with the Program Assistant Dean, Department Education Coordinator, or Director of Clinical Education and listed in the application, under “Mutually Agreed Educational Contributions”. Examples:
 - Clinical instructor/preceptor for student placements
 - Assessor for the MMI admissions interviews
 - Guest lecturer (identify area of expertise)
 - PBT tutorial leader
 - Evaluator for practical exams or assignments
 - Interprofessional education group facilitator
 - Program committee member

At Renewal Time

Each program enters the hours associated with each role into the centralized tracking system. The School of Rehabilitation Science reviews the completed roles, student ratings (for CI, tutor, and instructor roles), and recommendations from faculty to determine if the appointment will be renewed for another 3-year period.
